

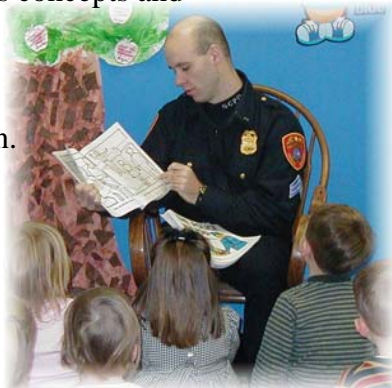
# About Our Preschool

- Encouragement and support of your child's ability to question, think and problem solve

- The introduction and practice of early reading skills including phonics and sight reading using a multisensory approach and incorporating developmentally appropriate practices
- The use of the "Handwriting Without Tears" program to simplify and maximize your child's early handwriting skills.
- Exploration and creation through hands-on activities and educational field trips

The activities presented throughout the curricula focus on particular themes, introduction of various concepts and include many subject areas: reading, social studies, math, science and physical education. Participation in the various activities allows children to understand and retain the newly discovered information.

- Afternoon program:* 12 - 2:30 pm OR 12:15 - 2:45 pm
- Tuition:* 2 Day \$205/month
- 3rd day option:** Wednesday
- Morning:* 9 - 11:30 am
- 3rd Day Tuition:* Additional \$95/month
- Application fee:* \$50 non-refundable/child

## Enrollment Information

- Our preschool follows the Smithtown School District calendar.
- To qualify for enrollment, your child must be the required age for their program by December 1st of the school year.
- A copy of your child's birth certificate must be submitted at the time of registration.
- CFA is a peanut-free zone! No snacks containing peanuts, peanut oil or peanut butter will be served without prior approval. We ask that parents adhere to this policy when bringing in treats for special occasions such as birthdays.
- Upon registration, we require that families complete our Family Contact & Emergency Form, especially noting any allergies.
- Toilet training is not required though we strongly encourage that your child be introduced to the idea. We also want you to know that our staff will work with you and your child to support the progress being made.
- CFA offers 2 payment plans for your convenience: monthly coupon payment book *or* automatic credit card deduction.
